Periodic vacuuming is recommended to prevent airborne dust from building up on the wallcovering surface.

The frequency of vacuuming should be increased in particularly polluted environments.

Cleaning

All Tapetex Wall Materials are finished with Teflon to provide increased protection against staining from most water and oil based agents.

When splashed, the contaminant will form beads on the surface of the wallcovering and, in most cases, these can be removed by gentle blotting with a clean absorbent tissue.

Remove any such splashes when still wet, but do not rub as you may push them into the wall material and create a stain.

Once stains are dried in, it is hardly possible to remove them. You may try gentle rubbing with a clean sponge or cloth dampened with a little neutral detergent solution, but make sure it's not too wet. Always work from the outside in towards the centre of the stain.

In the case of coffee, tea, fruit juices, etc., which can discolour once dry, try gentle dabbing with a neutral detergent solution, followed by lemon juice and finally dab with a clean dry cloth to remove any excess moisture.
